**DELAWARE RIVER JOINT TOLL BRIDGE COMMISSION
(DRJTBC) LAUNCHES WEBSITE AND HOTLINE FOR THE
I-95/SCUDDER FALLS BRIDGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT**

Bucks County, PA (September 29, 2003) – The Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission has launched a website and created a telephone hotline for the I-95/Scudder Falls Bridge Improvement Project. The Commission recently initiated the Improvement Project to address and improve safety and congestion at the Scudder Falls Bridge and along I-95 from PA Route 332 in Bucks County, Pennsylvania to Bear Tavern Road in Mercer County, New Jersey.
