PRE-PROJECT UTILITY RELOCATIONS COULD CAUSE MINOR DELAYS AT TAYLORSVILLE, WOODSIDE & RIVER ROADS NEXT WEEK

LOWER MAKEFIELD, PA – Motorists may encounter brief off-peak travel delays next week at various locations along Taylorsville, Woodside and River roads in Lower Makefield, PA. as PECO workers relocate utility lines in advance of the upcoming Scudder Falls Bridge Replacement Project, the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission announced today.

Flagger-controlled travel patterns may be in effect along any of the three affected roadways from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday, March 27, to Friday, March 31.

The scheduled restricted travel periods are subject to change due to weather, emergency, and traffic considerations. Motorists should reduce their speeds whenever traveling through designated work zones.
