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TRAVEL ADVISORY – Week of December 24

EWING, NJ – Travel restrictions for the Scudder Falls Bridge Replacement Project are scheduled to resume after a lane-closure moratorium for the Christmas holiday weekend ends Tuesday afternoon, Dec. 26, the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission announced today.

Project-related travel restrictions planned for the week of Dec. 24 are as follows:

New Jersey side

- Route 175/River Road – **OVERNIGHT** full closure in vicinity of the I-95 approach overpass to the Scudder Falls Bridge 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. (next day) Tuesday, Dec. 26 through Thursday, Dec. 28. (Note: On-ramp to I-95 will be inaccessible during the overnight closure periods; affected motorists should [follow the posted detour routes](#).); **AND** **DAYTIME** alternating single-lane travel controlled by flaggers between I-95 and West Upper Ferry Road noon to 5 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 26 and 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 27 and Thursday, Dec. 28.
- Route 29 interchange with I-95 – Single lane patterns in each direction on Route 29 in project area 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. and restricted ramp widths 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 26 to Thursday, Dec. 28.

Pennsylvania side

- I-95 north from the Route 332/Newtown-Yardley interchange (Exit 49) to the Scudder Falls Bridge – intermittent single-lane travel configurations noon to 6 a.m. (next day) Tuesday, Dec. 26 and 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Wednesday, Dec. 27 through Thursday, Dec. 28.
- I-95 south from the Scudder Falls Bridge to the Route 332/Newtown-Yardley interchange (exit 49) – intermittent single-lane travel pattern 8 p.m. to 2 p.m. (next day) Tuesday, Dec. 26 through Thursday, Dec. 28 (Note: Thursday's overnight lane closure must be lifted no later than 6 a.m. Friday, Dec. 29).
- Taylorsville Road in vicinity of I-95 – Intermittent single-lane patterns in each direction 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 26 to Thursday, Dec. 28.
- Woodside Road west of Taylorsville Road – Intermittent alternating single-lane travel controlled by flaggers 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 26 to Thursday, Dec. 28.
- River Road/Route 32 – Intermittent alternating single-lane travel controlled by flaggers 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday, Dec. 26 to Thursday, Dec. 28.

Canal Towpaths –The canal towpaths on both sides of the current bridge will be fully open. An anticipated closure of the Delaware Canal towpath in Pennsylvania has been postponed and will not be implemented until Jan. 2 at the earliest.



New Year's Holiday Weekend: A moratorium on project-related lane closures is scheduled to begin 6 a.m. Friday, Dec. 29, and remain in effect until noon Tuesday, Jan. 2, 2018.

The aforementioned travel restrictions are subject to change due to weather, emergency, traffic, and **equipment/materials** mobilization considerations. Motorists are urged to allow extra time to reach their destinations, and to reduce speeds and exercise caution when travelling through project work areas.
