PROJECT TRAVEL ADVISORY – Friday, March 2 through Friday March 9

NJ Route 175/River Road On-Ramp to I-95 North in Ewing To Close Overnights Next Week near Scudder Falls Bridge

Follow Posted Detours Routes during Weeknight Closure Periods

EWING, NJ – The I-95 northbound on-ramp from River Road/NJ Route 175 is scheduled to be closed during overnight hours Monday through Friday next week to allow for Scudder Falls Bridge Replacement Project construction activities. In addition, overnight closures and detours will be implemented this weekend and potentially Monday at the I-95/Route 29 interchange (Exit 1) and along Route 29 Southbound in the vicinity of the bridge.

A previously imposed set of detour routes will again be implemented to direct affected motorists onto I-95 north (soon-to-be-designated I-295 south). A map of the prescribed detour routes is attached.

The River Road/NJ Route 175 ramp travel restriction is scheduled to be in place 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. (next day) on Monday, March 5 through Friday, March 9. This restriction and detours may be delayed until Tuesday, March 6 if weather conditions this weekend require extending the timeframe for project work on Route 29 and the Interchange Ramps.

The full schedule of travel restrictions for the Scudder Falls Bridge Replacement Project for this weekend and the week of March 4 are as follows:

New Jersey side

- I-95/Route 29 interchange (Exit 1) – OVERNIGHT on and off ramp closures at the Route 29 and I-95 interchange, as well as Route 29 (southbound) on Friday, March 2 from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. (next day), Saturday, March 3 from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. (next day), and on Sunday March 4 and Monday, March 5 (if necessary) from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. (next day). Detour maps for this closure pattern may be found on the project website's homepage at www.scudderfallsbridge.com. In addition, on Route 29 in the vicinity of the bridge, there will be daily lane closures (one lane maintained) from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Monday, March 5 through Friday, March 9.
- Route 175/River Road – Intermittent alternating single-lane travel controlled by flaggers 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, March 5, to Friday, March 9.
- Route 175/River Road on-ramp to I-95 north/I-295 south – OVERNIGHT closure with posted detour 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. (next morning) Monday, March 5, through Friday, March 9. (As stated previously, the start of this detour could potentially be delayed until Tuesday March 6 depending on weather conditions this weekend).



Pennsylvania side

- I-95 north from the Route 332/Newtown-Yardley interchange (Exit 49) to the Scudder Falls Bridge – Intermittent single-lane travel patterns 10 a.m. to 6 a.m. (next day) Monday, March 5, through Friday, March 9.
- I-95 south from the Scudder Falls Bridge to the Route 332/Newtown-Yardley interchange (exit 49) – Intermittent single-lane travel patterns 8 p.m. to 2 p.m. (next day) Monday, March 5, through Friday, March 9.
- Taylorsville Road in vicinity of I-95 - Intermittent single-lane patterns 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday, March 5, to Friday, March 9.
- Woodside Road (west of Taylorsville Road) - Intermittent single-lane patterns 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday, March 5, to Friday, March 9.
- River Road/Route 32 – Intermittent alternating single-lane travel controlled by flaggers 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday, March 5, to Friday, March 9.

The aforementioned scheduled travel restrictions are subject to change due to weather, emergency, traffic, and equipment/materials mobilization considerations. Motorists are urged to allow extra time to reach their destinations, and to reduce speeds and exercise caution when travelling through project work areas.
