OVERNIGHT SINGLE-LANE CLOSURES ON I-95 SOUTH AT SCUDDER FALLS BRIDGE NEXT WEEK

Travel Restriction Needed for Removal of Trees from River Island in New Bridge's Path

EWING, NJ – I-95 southbound in the vicinity of the Scudder Falls Bridge is scheduled to be reduced to a single lane during three overnight periods next week, the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission announced today.

The single-lane travel restriction is needed for the clearing and hoisting of trees off a river island that will be affected by upcoming construction of the Scudder Falls Replacement Bridge.

When in effect, the scheduled single-lane travel pattern will begin near the Bear Tavern Road/Route 579 interchange (Exit 2) in Ewing, N.J. and continue to the southern end of the bridge in Lower Makefield, PA. The times and dates will be as follows:

- 8 p.m. Monday, April 3, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, April 4;
- 8 p.m. Tuesday, April 4, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 5; and
- 8 p.m. Wednesday, April 5 to 6 a.m. Thursday, April 6.

The scheduled restricted travel periods are subject to change due to weather, emergency, and traffic considerations. Motorists should reduce their speeds whenever traveling through designated work zones.
